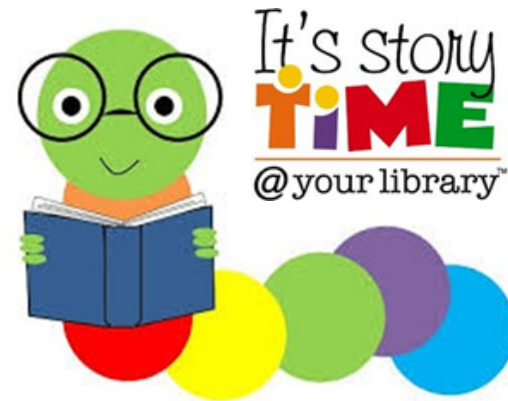

- **Reading:** When you're reading with your child, you are helping them become independent readers.
